**2pts. for Steps**  $\underline{C}$  &  $\underline{O}$ : proper heading and organized notes,

1pt (extra credit semester 1) for Step R: highlight or circle key terms, # and underline or set apart the main ideas/chunks in some other way, revision should be done in a different color

**2pt. for Step N**: questions/main ideas/key terms in the left margin (2+ questions per page of notes), and **2pt. for Step L**: a descriptive 5+ sentence summary at the end of the notes (summary should address the essential question and demonstrate your understanding of the lesson)

A complete and detailed Learning Log can earn you 4 points, Partially complete = 2 points

**Learning Log** is 7-10 sentences long and follows the provided **template**. The writing is descriptive, mentioning the activity and placing a heavy emphasis on what was learned as a result of the lesson and it's significance/connection to other topics studied in class.
